

## **Buggies**

Any member or visitor with a disability within the meaning of the Disability Discrimination Legislation who is unable to play golf unless aided by the use of a buggy may, use either one of the Club's or their own four wheeled two seater or three or four wheeled, single seater buggy.

Following a detailed Risk Review, it has been decided that three or four wheeled single seater or four wheeled two seater buggies may be used, but due to the steep terrain on some holes strict rules on safe usage and safe routes have been defined. Breach of these rules may lead to the suspension or withdrawal of the right to use buggies.

The Club has only a limited number of buggies and any visitor wishing to use one should contact the Club in advance to ensure that one will be available when required. It will be helpful if visitors wishing to use their own buggy also contact the Club at least five days in advance to ensure that all of the requirements can be met.

The Course Manager's daily recorded message on course conditions (available on 01202 706121) will now also indicate if the course or a part of the course is not in a suitable condition for use by buggies on that day.

The requirements for the use of a buggy include:

- The production of a medical certificate stating their need under the Disability Discrimination Legislation.
- The production of a valid certificate of insurance for third party liabilities if using their own buggy
- The acceptance of the Club's Safety Policy and signature of the Acknowledgement Form.

The Club does not have the facility to store or recharge members' or visitors' own buggies. Any member or visitor wishing to use their own buggy will therefore need to bring it to and remove it from the course and club premises on each occasion that they wish to use it.

Users of golf buggies do so at their own risk. Parkstone Golf Club has no responsibility for ensuring the safe operation of ride-on buggies on or beyond the confines of the course and the club car-parks other than those operated by their servants or agents. The Club will not accept any liability for any loss or damage to the golf buggy or any other property arising from the negligence of the club or any of its servants or agents.'
